

# The development of an Evidence Review support service in Cardiff University

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## Why?

- Seconded to project post September 2018
- Consistency in approach
- Subject librarians to work collaboratively with <u>Specialist Unit for</u> <u>Review Evidence</u>





- Recommendations to Senior Management Team
- Task & Finish group with relevant stakeholders



## What?

#### Recommendation:

*Core:* The University Library Service will provide 1-2-1 assistance to Cardiff University staff and PGRs, up to and including use of databases and any subsequent assistance such as peer reviewing their search

*Charged:* Developing and running a search, sifting abstracts, sifting full text, critical appraisal, assisting with either writing a protocol or review.



## Training recommendations:

- Established team by opening up expressions of interest
- Team of approx. 15 with varying experience
- Considered training workshops but felt these weren't at point of need
- Peer training



## Charging:

- Can vary depending on funding/grant
- Daily rate based on the subject librarian grade
- Estimate days depending on researcher need



## Promotion:

- Soft launch September 2019
  - All subject librarians informed for the service
  - Work undertaken based on being approached by those who would have likely approached us anyway
- Next phase April 2020
  - Staff intranet pages
  - Active promotion to targeted individuals/teams in the university



## What we've learnt (so far):

- Researchers have been amendable to paying for the service
- Set standards
- Keep clear record
- Demonstrate impact
